




## What we are learning in Nursery Term 1: Our theme this term is 'Marvelous Me'

<b>Reminders</b>	Our PE day is Wednesday. Please send your child into school wearing PE kit every Wednesday. Please ensure all belongings are named. Children should only have water in their bottles. Please can children also bring a pair of wellies that can stay in Nursery.
<b>Phonics</b>	We will be focusing on what we can hear and listening to different sounds in our environment. We will also be exploring making sounds with our bodies and with musical instruments.
<b>Maths</b>	This term we will be focusing on hearing and joining in with different number and colour songs and will be beginning to incorporate number language into our play.
<b>Communication and Language</b>	We will be doing lots of talking to our new friends and learning how to be super listeners during carpet and circle time.
<b>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</b>	 Our Jigsaw piece is called 'Being Me in My World' where we will be exploring similarities and differences and finding out what makes us special and unique.
<b>Physical Development</b>	This term, we will be practicing becoming increasingly independent in meeting own care needs – hand washing / eating / toileting etc. In PE we will be using our gross motor skills- including running, jumping and climbing.
<b>Understanding the World</b>	We will be focusing on exploring our new Nursery environment both indoors and outdoors. We will also be thinking about what makes us special.
<b>Expressive Arts and Design</b>	The artist of the term is Jackson Pollock, who created art by splashing and dripping paints using a variety of colours.

### Ways in which you can support your child's learning at home this term:

Encouraging your child to speak in full sentences.

Reading to your child at home and sharing stories together.

Helping your child to notice numbers in the environment.

Encourage conversations about holidays and experiences.
