Adding and Subtracting

- Add two 2-digit numbers (across a 10)
- Subtract two 2-digit numbers (across a 10)
- Mixed addition and subtraction

Shape

- Recognise 2-D and 3-D shapes
- Count sides and vertices on 2D
- Count faces, edges and vertices on 3D shapes.

History -

- To understand Civilisations become more advanced over time.
- To understand how the way people travel, trade and go on holiday changed.
- To understand that Queen Victoria was an important public figure
- To understand how Britain gained power by invading other countries.

- Fundamental skills development - throwing, catching and coordination.

Music - Water

- To explore sounds of the sea using voices and instruments.

Writing

Classic and contemporary poetry:

- Edward Lear's *The Owl and the Pussycat*

Writing to persuade:

Phonics
