Whole class reading text types:

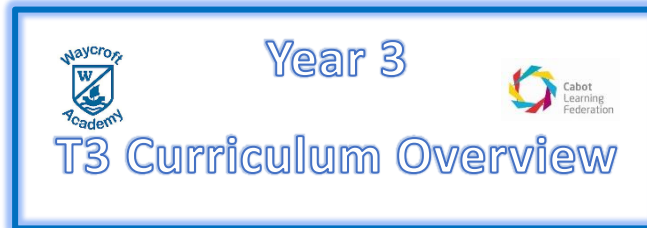
- Information texts on light and the Romans.

Geography- UK Local study- counties, cities in South-West:

- Make a recorded presentation with an imposed image on a green screen.



Art- Painting:

- Experiment with the techniques of 'impasto', 'tonking' and 'sgraffito'.
